## How to fill in Score Sheets

- All sections of the score sheet MUST be filled out correctly each match.
- Penalties and fines are issued to clubs for incorrect or missing information on score sheets.
- Teams can lose competition points for playing illegal players or for repeated infringements.
- A forfeit may be claimed if opposition cannot field the minimum team of five players within five minutes from commencement of game.
- NB: All players from both teams who are at the grounds must still have photos sighted \& ticked on the score sheet for forfeit points to be awarded
- Please notify window of any team forfeits when returning score sheet


## PLAYING A PLAYER FROM ANOTHER TEAM/GRADE

- Please be sure to fill in the borrowed players section on the score sheet. You must include Players Name, registered Team \& Division \& Tick when player photo cards are sighted.
- A team may play a maximum of 2 players up from a lower grade in any one game.
- Junior players are restricted to playing within 2 age groups.
- $10 y r s$ old can play in 11 yrs or $12 y r s$ teams.
- 11 yrs old can play 12 yrs or $13 y r s$ teams.
- $12 y r s$ old can play $13 y r s$ or $14 y r s$ teams.
- $13 y r s$ old can play $14 y r s$ or $15 y r s$ team.
- $14 y$ y old can play $15 y r s$ or Cadets.
- 15yr old can play in Cadets.
- Cadets can play in Senior Divisions.
- A player may play a maximum of 3 games for any team, in any higher grade throughout the season.
- If any player plays a 4th (fill-in) game for any other team, in any other grade - they are automatically upgraded into this higher team \& division - there are no exceptions to this. This will automatically occur when a player plays up for a total of 4 games - no matter what team you play up for or the duration you may have played that $4^{\text {th }}$ (fill in) game
- Even if you don't play that game but are sighted \& ticked on the score sheet that counts as playing up for that team.
- If your name is ticked on the score card you are deemed to have played for that team whether you take the court or not.


## Modified Score Sheet - 8 Years

- 8 year teams must rotate playing positions
- A player can play the same position for two quarters only
- Players should experience all positions in a season
- Each team has their own score sheet to fill in \& sign
- Player positions are recorded on the score sheet for each quarter
- Rotations are recorded at Association level; No goals or attempts are recorded
- Players are deemed to be sighted by recording positions played
- 8 year players can play across grades if a team is short (Max. of 2 players, per match)



## Modified Score Sheet - 9 Years

- Each team must sight opposition team photos
- Place a tick in the column provided - ONLY IF THEY PLAY
- If a name is missing, write on at the bottom, tick only if played
- There are no requirements to rotate players - It is best practice to rotate through all positions so players become comfortable with all positions on the court
- Record goals scored for Association statistical purposes
- 9 year players can play across grades if a team is short (Max. of 2 players, per match)
- ENSURE Borrowed players photos are sighted and ticked
- You must advise if any errors on the score sheet when returning it to the window
** You must sight the opposition team photos \& tick the column next to each of the players playing the match. The person who does the sighting must also sign below with the Captain \& Scorer**

** For all borrowed players, you must write Players Name; Players registered Team name \& Division \& tick the sighted column when the player cards are sighted.

NB: Max. of 2 players, per match

## Score Sheet-10'S to Seniors

- Each team must sight opposition team photos
- Place a tick in the column provided - ONLY IF THEY PLAY
- If a name is missing, write on at the bottom, tick only if played
- Provide FULL details of players playing up - Max of TWO PLAYERS, per match ONLY
- PRINT CLEARLY
- ENSURE borrowed players photos are sighted and ticked - ONLY IF THEY PLAY
- You must advise if any errors on the score sheet when returning it to the window
** You must sight the opposition team photos \& tick the column next to each of the players playing the match. The person who does the sighting must also sign below with the Captain \& Scorer**

** For Borrowed players, you must write Players Name; tick the sighted column when the player cards are sighted \& write the Players registered Team Name \& Division.
> ** The Team captain; The Scorer/s \& the person who sighted the opposition team photos must sign the score sheet
